## Reviewing Recorded Video via Center Software

Please ensure that Dignet Center software has been installed on the PC on which you intend to review the software, and that the video was recorded from the DVR correctly. Please contact us to obtain instructions for either of those procedures.

It is recommended that you never install the Dignet Center Software onto your DVR, as this may cause the system to operate improperly. The DVR is only to be used as a Digital Video Recorder, never as a Personal Computer(PC).

### Reviewing Instructions

---

1. Insert your Recorded CD into the CDROM drive on the PC where you installed the Dignet Center software.
2. Double-click on the Dignet Center Icon on the desktop.
3. When the "Enter Password" box appears you can set a password, or leave the password blank. *(You will have to confirm the password if this is the first time you have loaded the Dignet Center Software)*
4. Once the password is entered, the Dignet Center Software will load.
5. Next, Click on the **Search** button from the menu on the right-hand side.
6. When the "Search Mode Select" screen appears **Backup data** should be selected.
7. Now, select your CDROM drive from the drop-down menu. *Your CDROM will most likely be drive D: or E:*
8. When you select the proper drive you should see an encrypted code in the Site code list. This is your recorded video. *If you have recorded more than one incident onto one CD, there will be more than one encrypted code in the list.*
9. Select the Incident that you wish to review.
10. Click **OK**.
11. Your screen will now turn over to Search mode. *It will look similar to that of the DVR search mode.*
12. The Day of the Incident will now show up in **Red** on the Calendar.
13. Select the Day of the Incident on the calendar.
14. Select the time of the incident under the calendar. *Hint: If you select a time before the time of your incident the software will automatically jump to the beginning of your recording, when you click **PLAY**.*
15. Lastly, you will need to select the camera you wish to view. *(It is recommended that you view no more than four cameras at a time, to ensure that your PC can handle the video load. If you fail to do this you may experience lock-ups, and other various PC problems.)*
16. Press the **Play** button.
17. Once the video starts to playback, you will be able to use your action buttons (*Stop, Play, FF, RW, etc...*), also using the delay to slow down the recording to a more comfortable viewing level.
